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LAY PUPILS FEES

REGISTRATION:

£10 is to be paid on entering a girl's name for admission. Upon acceptance of a vacancy, £100 is paid as a deposit and this will be deducted from the first Fee Account.

BOARDERS £1,012.00 per term* £3,036.00 per annum

DAY GIRLS:

Senior Girls £550.00 per term* £1,650 per annum

Junior Girls £500.00 per term £1,500 per annum

Transition £222.00 per term £ 666 per annum

All fees are payable termly in advance before the first day of term.

In the case of new girls whose parents or guardians are overseas, a deposit of £1,000 will be required one month before she enters the School. This sum will be available to use on her behalf in case of an emergency, and of course we would ask for it to be replaced as soon as possible. The deposit would be used to meet her final account, after which any balance will be returned.

Meals for Day Girls taken at School are charged.

NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL

Notice of withdrawal of a pupil must be given before the first day of term in writing to the Headmaster (i.e. one full term's notice), otherwise full fees for the ensuing term must be paid.

EXHIBITIONS

One at £500 per annum.

One at £500 per annum for daughters of clergymen of the Church of England.

All of these, tenable up to and including Sixth Form level, are available for candidates over 10 years of age and under 14 on 1st September.

SIXTH FORM AWARDS

One offering full tuition fees and One at £500 per annum.

One offering full tuition fees and One offering half tuition fees to daughters of clergymen of the Church of England.

These are awarded on the results of an interview to be held in the school in March followed by the results of the G.C.E. 'O' level examination.

MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP

One of £500 per annum, and also free tuition in two instruments, for candidates who will be aged 11 or over on 1st September. This award, tenable up to and including Sixth Form level, will be decided on the result of an interview and practical test to be held in March. The youngest applicants should have attained at least Grade 3 standard in the Royal Schools of Music Examinations.
